

**FACULTY DISCLOSURE FORM  
AND CONTENT VALIDATION**

Faculty/speaker's disclosure information will be included in the activity's handout materials. If a completed form is not returned to the activity's coordinator prior to the production of the activity's handout, the statement **"refused to disclosed"** will be included in the handout materials and the faculty will be required to verbally communicate his/her disclosure information at the educational activity.

**Disclosure Information**

Faculty at sponsored CME activities must disclose to participants the presence of relationships with commercial companies whose products are discussed in their presentations. Relationships include: grants or research support; employee; consultant; stockholder; or member of speaker bureau that occurred within 12 months preceding the activity.

Faculty must also disclose if they are discussing products that are investigational or not labeled for use being discussed. Presentations by themselves, or in conjunction with other presentations, must give a balance view of the therapeutic options. Use of generic names of products contributes to impartiality. If trade names are used, those of several companies should be used.

Disclosure is to provide participants with information that might be of potential importance to their evaluation of a presentation.
